

Dear OLM Friends,

When a parent or grandparent is struggling, the last thing on their mind may be Christmas. But each year, we get the opportunity to take the burden off of struggling families by helping them give their children everything from basic needs like coats and shoes to gifts for every child in the household. Your support makes Christmas a time of celebration and wonder for children, families, and singles who may have no one else to provide for them in this special season. There are a number of ways that you or your group can get involved at various levels of giving to help families in need this year:

- 1) Donate Christmas Basket Items: You can help us provide a Christmas meal and additional household necessities for families in need including socks, winter wear items, toiletries, soap, and paper products (see our chart below for suggested collection items).
- 2) Donate Toys: Collect new-in-box toys for children in need. Adults will have the opportunity to "shop" for their children when they pick up their Christmas Wishes baskets (suggestion list provided upon request). Highest needed items are for ages 12-17.
- 3) Sponsor a Family: Groups and individuals may opt to provide an entire Christmas experience for a family in need based on their application. Your group can specify the ages, household size, or circumstance you would like to sponsor and provide a Christmas meal basket, presents, and (if possible) any urgent household needs. Your group will determine the level of involvement and items given to the sponsored family, and may choose to present the gifts to the family or arrange a pickup during our OLM office hours. - **4) Volunteer for Basket and Toy Pickup:** Volunteers will be used on Wednesday, December 11th from 9-11:30 a.m. (or until completion) to put together Christmas food & hygiene baskets. Volunteers will also be needed to serve as "shopping assistants" Thurs Dec 12th, Friday Dec. 13th, and Sat Dec. 14th from 9:00am 12:00 pm or 1:00pm 4:00 pm to help families "shop" (for free!) (Sat afternoon cleanup 1-4 p.m.)

We hope that you will be able to be involved in one or more of our programs. We are happy to provide fliers to help get the message out to your group. Please contact us to communicate your plans for collections, family or monetary sponsorship, or to reserve your volunteer slot. Together, we can continue to provide help for today and hope for tomorrow!
